Wax-up is also great for improving your shape, morphology, and texture skills. If you learn how to create a beautiful tooth with wax, you can complete the same with other materials.

1. <u>Electric wax knives - provided on</u> <u>the course!</u>

Ideally, two knives, one thinner and one medium size probe.

The thinner for fine details, the thicker for the quicker build up.
